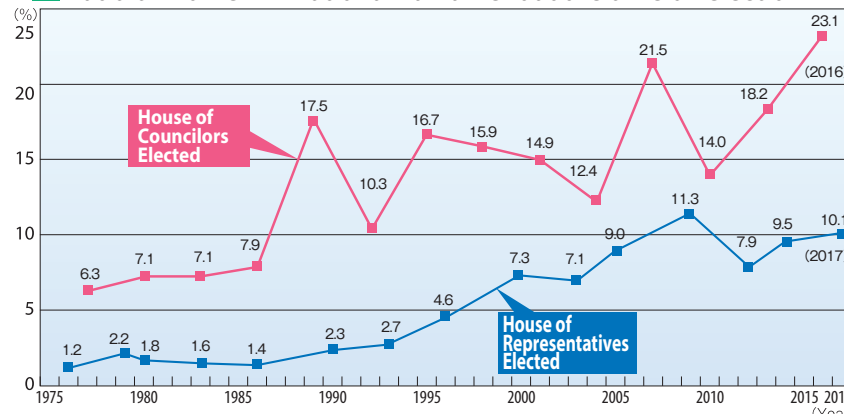

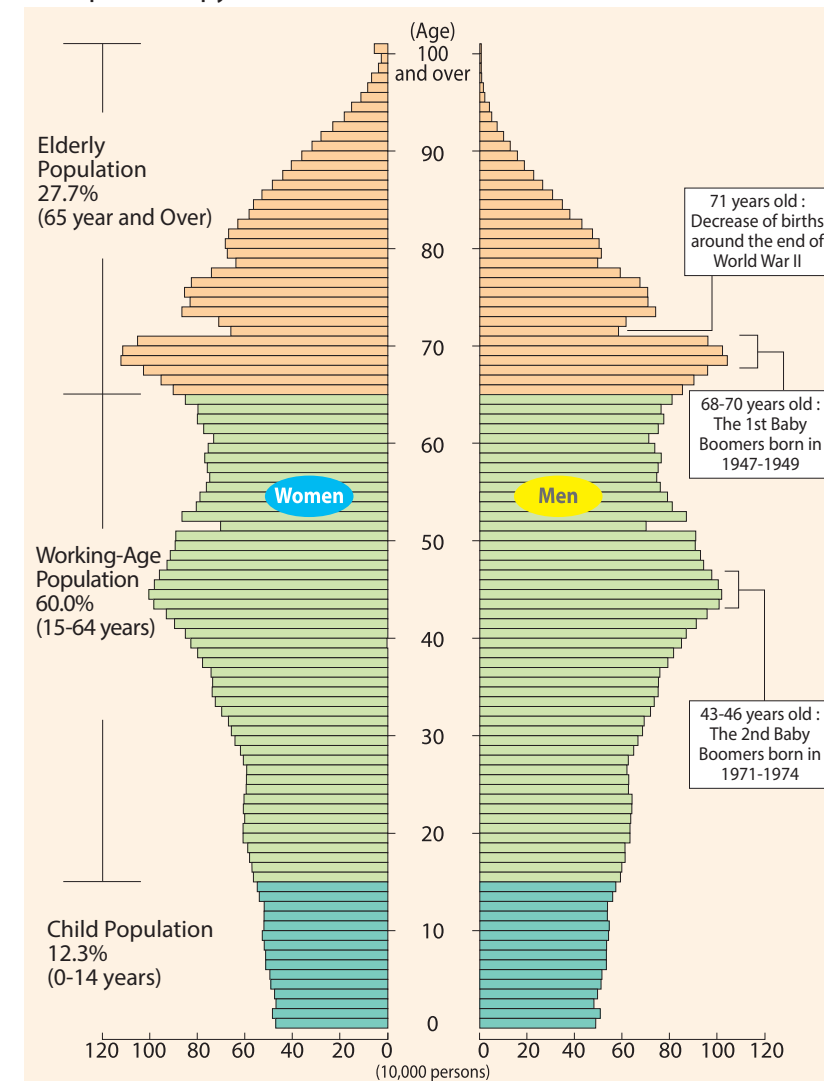

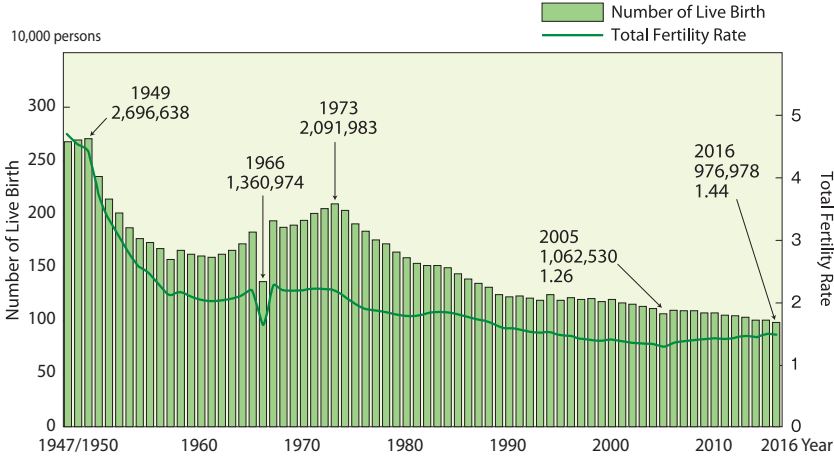

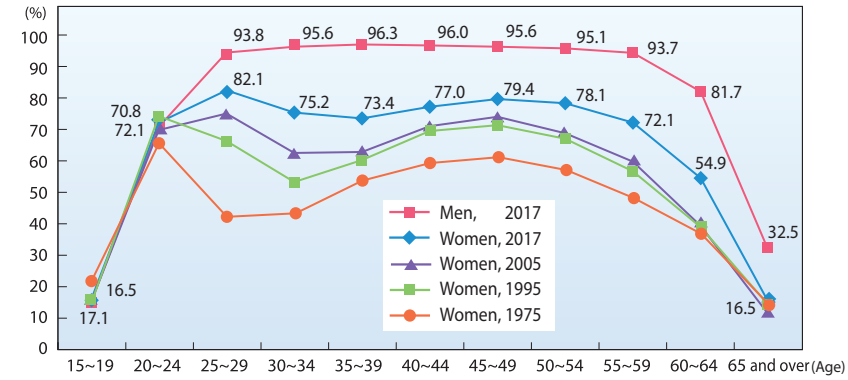

### 2 Labour force participation rate by age groups



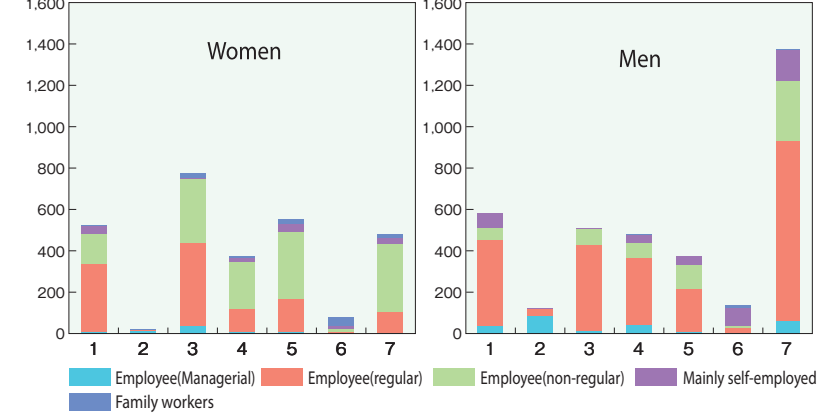
